



Directions to O2 Concert Venue from Ashfield House

Ashfield House is a great base for going to concerts in the O2 Venue, as you can walk easily from the hostel to the O2, and we are still in the city centre for other sightseeing or socialising you would like to do.

Walking to the O2 from Ashfield House: 20 Minutes

Turn right outside the door and walk to the end of D'Olier Street. Turn right here, at O'Connell Bridge, and walk along the River Liffey to the next bridge, which is Tara St Bridge. Cross over the River Liffey here and turn right. The beautiful Custom House building is on your left and the River Liffey is now on your right.

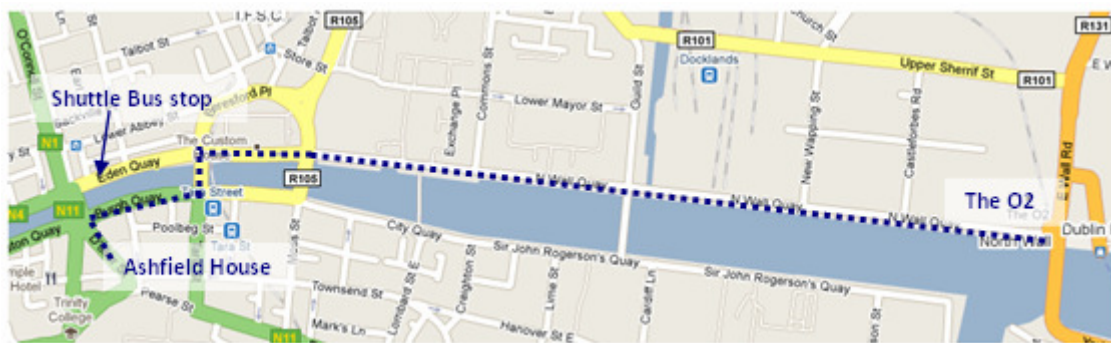
Keep walking along the river for about 15 minutes and you will see the O2 venue on your left hand side.

Along the way, you will pass some interesting sights as you walk through the Dublin Docklands, including the bleak Famine Memorial sculpture, the Jeanie Johnson tall ship (when she is docked in Dublin) and the cool CHQ building.

Shuttle Bus to the O2 from Ashfield House: 10 Minutes

Turn right outside the door and cross over O'Connell Bridge. Turn right on to Eden Quay; the River Liffey is on your right hand side. On the left hand side of Eden Quay, the bus stop for the KBR shuttle bus service to the O2 is outside the Laughter Lounge.

The official KBR shuttle bus runs approximately every 20 minutes and costs €3 one way / €5 return.
