Valpolicella Classico Superiore D.O.C

Verona, Italy – Tommasi 2002

Full bodied, intense, smooth with a long finish

Burgundy, France – Bouchard Aine, Pinossimo 2003

Blackcurrant liquorish and black cherry flavours with a long lasting vanilla finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva

Chile - Santa Rita 2002

Medium bodied wine with aromas of black fruit, undertones of vanilla, cloves and spices.

Blended with some viognier grapes, this wine is explosive on the palate, super rich and full bodied. Beautifully balanced with integrated tannin, wood and acidity.
